It is important to remember that the reception of these sacraments is just the beginning of a journey of sharing in the sacraments which continues right through life.

Further education in faith
through the home, school and parish,
will help the children to grow in their appreciation
of these sacraments.

## What is Sacramental Program?

The Sacraments are a key part of church life and are celebrated within our Parish church community.

Each year the Catholic Parish of Mareeba offers a special program to help candidates and families prepare for the celebration of the Sacraments of First Reconciliation (Confession), Confirmation and First Eucharist (Communion) for all children in the Parish of eligible age regardless of which school they attend.

In the Cairns Diocese, children who are in Year 4 and above are eligible to prepare for and celebrate the Sacraments mentioned above.

Our Sacramental Preparation Program places a strong emphasis on family involvement, as we recognize that parents/guardians are the main educators in faith of their children.

Our Sacramental Preparation Program is undertaken over two school terms.

This preparation is designed not only to prepare the candidates receiving the Sacrament, but also to involve and inform the parents and other family members, so that the experience can be shared as part of the family's faith journey.

For each of the Sacraments there is a series of compulsory online lessons which will help prepare children to receive the sacrament, and one compulsory group gathering where they will be welcomed to the program and will receive a special blessing.

- submit a copy of the candidates' Baptism Certificate
- pay \$50.00 to the Parish Office
